Our policy is to use specific commands and praise to gain successful behaviors and compliance vs. "No!" or "Stop that!" which are too general and confusing to dogs. Below is a list of specific commands we use in daycare that you may want to reinforce at home to better acclimate your dog(s) to our daycare program. We will use your personal commands as you have detailed above along with ours to gain the best results. Most important is name recall. We will use time outs and quiet times to help our clients' dogs learn good manners.

"Come here" = to cover both "come" & "here"

"Wait" = be patient

"Sit" = (open & close waist high fist each time said)

"Leave it" = drop it/move away

"Stay" = don't move (palm out toward muzzle)

"Easy"/"Settle" = calm down/rest

"Down" = lie down (index finger downward)

"Outside" = let's go outside

"Off" = stop jumping/ get off

"Go potty"/"Go poo"/"Hurry up"

"Get back" = wait for permission to enter (arm at side with palm back into muzzle)

"Quiet" = stop vocalizing

"Free" = release command

"No Bite" for play biting, nibbling, rough play
